Metal roofing panels from Coastal Metal Service were selected for the first home to earn the Insurance Institute for Business & Home Safety FORTIFIED Gold designation. Built in Surf City, N.C., the home was designed to withstand natural disasters.

"By using concrete walls that satisfies the one requirement, then topping it off with a metal roof which is designed to withstand 170 miles per hour winds, all we needed then was windows and doors that would meet those types of impact and wind ratings," said Thomas Dugan, the builder.
